1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Virgin Islands Office of Disaster Recovery (ODR), a subsidiary division of the Virgin Islands Public Finance Authority, an independent instrumentality of the Government of the United States Virgin Islands is soliciting quotes from marketing and graphic design companies ("Respondent") to develop the layout, infographics, and design for the Office of Disaster Recovery's 2025 Annual Recovery Progress Report.

2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES

This eighth report for September 2025 will encompass the dynamic design of approximately 30 A3-sized (11x17) sheets, stapled to a double-sided cardstock cover printed in color. The Respondent shall design the report, including all infographics and the presentation of data. Pictures, text, and raw data will be provided. The design can be developed using Adobe InDesign or Canva. It must be submitted to ODR upon request in high-resolution, printable, and PDF versions, as well as the "InDesign" files or access to the Canva file.

Scope of work includes:

- Design of report
- Layout of all pages
- Design of accompanying infographics
- Any requested edits
- Submittal of requested formats

The quote should include all costs associated with delivering a final product as outlined above.

3.0 REQUIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS OF RESPONDENT The following subsections require minimum qualifications:

- a. Respondents will be competing for selection to provide design services. The submissions of all Respondents shall be compared and evaluated pursuant to the Public Finance Authority's (PFA) Procurement Policy for Requests for Quotations, which states, "To the extent possible, the selection shall be made of the company with the lowest responsive responsible quote."
- b. Respondent's bid packages must include a completed bid sheet and three samples of similar work.
- c. Respondents must also provide their Unique Entity Identifier that is actively registered on SAM.GOV and current USVI Business License specific to the Scope of Services.
- d. Quotations shall be valid for a period of 30 days from the deadline for submission indicated in the E-Bid solicitation.
